Flexibility - WIs can apply the flexibility policy to their 2025/26 subscription. This means that your WI can charge the full amount of the WI portion, reduce the portion, or waive the WI portion of the subscription entirely. *Dual members* will pay the WI portion only to their second WI. If the WI is not utilising the flexibility policy, this will be £25.10. There is no pro-rata rate for dual membership, and the set fee will remain payable at any time during the year. Your **Membership booklet** was included in your copy of 'WI Life'.

No Pooling of fares - Please note – due to Annual Meetings in 2025 and 2026 being conducted entirely online, Federation and WIs will not be required to pay Pooling of Fares nor Pooling of Costs.
