In October, Federation representatives nationwide met to discuss this year's 58 resolutions and select the shortlist of 4 which all members can now consider. Select the one you would most like to see go forward to the Annual Meeting in June 2024. If adopted at that meeting it will become a campaign. The 4 resolutions are detailed in the current issue of WI Life and further resources are available on MyWI.

Our Federation is holding a Resolutions Meeting on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> January from 10.00am-1pm when there will be For and Against debates. These will be presented by members of 4 WIs -one for each Resolution, with an opportunity for questions. No voting will take place at this meeting. Following this, each WI is expected to arrange a meeting to present the Resolutions and allow members to vote individually for the ONE Resolution they prefer.

The number of votes received for EACH Resolution must then be forwarded to Ein Swyddfa to arrive no later than 11<sup>th</sup> February 2024.
